No. MTA. 1760/33456-XII.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section (2) of section 13 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1958 (BOM. LXV OF 1958), the Government of Maharashtra is pleased to exempt Motor Vehicles mentioned in the first column of the schedule hereto from payment of the tax imposed under the said Act to the extent shown in the second column thereof:—
